Q. What activities or studies have NLH undertaken to determine the role that
Demand Side Management plays in the future demand and energy
requirements of the province?

A. Hydro continues to support HYDROWISE, an information and educational effort to enable consumers to make informed decisions regarding energy consumption. In addition, Hydro has recently restructured its wholesale tariff to Newfoundland Power. The demand-energy tariff is designed to reflect Hydro's cost structure and to convey an appropriate pricing signal to the retail utility for considering demand side management resources. On Hydro's own high cost diesel systems, the run-up in fuel costs in recent years has resulted in an initiative to deliver compact fluorescent lighting (CFL) to domestic diesel accounts in an effort to reduce financial loss and educate customers on CFL technology.
