Q. Which Federal regulations are being violated by the continued use of
refrigerant R-22?

A. At present there are no federal regulations violated by the continued use of refrigerant R-22. The R-22 refrigerant is a hydrocholorofluorocarbon (HCFC) regulated by federal Ozone – depleting Substances Regulations, 1998 SOR/99-7 and provincial Halocarbon Regulations, 2005 Newfoundland Regulation 41/05. Beginning in 2004, refrigerant R-22 consumption allowances to major suppliers are reduced and will be virtually eliminated by 2030. Between 2004 and 2009, the consumption allowances will be reduced by

35%. This means that in future, it will be difficult to procure refrigerant R-22.
