1	Q.	Has Hydro asked the Minister or the Department to delineate what
2		would be considered a material exceedance of the emission standards
3		under the Air Pollution Control Regulations in terms of causing a
4		prosecution to be launched or a fine to be levied against Hydro? What
5		does the Ministry consider to be a material exceedance?
6		
7		
8	A.	Hydro has not asked the Department of Environment and Conservation to
9		delineate or disclose the point of exceedance at which a decision would be
10		made to prosecute a polluter pursuant to the Air Pollution Control
11		Regulations, 2004 and the Environmental Protection Act. Hydro is bound by
12		that legislation and is, therefore, required to adhere to the pollution limits
13		prescribed therein.
