  - Table 1 below provides the revenue per full time equivalent employee (FTE) for the years 1998 to forecast 2004. Revenue for the years 1998-2002 includes revenue from electrical rates plus other revenue. For the years 2003 and 2004, the calculation is based on proposed revenue requirement, including revenue from electrical rates, other revenue and 2001 excess revenue applied as proposed. Details of revenue by year can be found in Exhibit BVP-1.
