- 8 A. Mr. Hughes' work for Fortis Inc. and its subsidiaries is captured on time sheets. The
  9 timesheet system indicates the affiliated company for whom the work is performed.
  10 Actual details of the work performed are not captured in the timesheet system.

Table 1 summarizes the charges by Mr. Hughes based on his rate of compensation in that year plus appropriate payroll overheads (vacation and benefits) for the period 1999 to 2002. In 1998, Mr. Hughes did not perform work for affiliated companies. To list each individual charge separately would take significant effort that Newfoundland Power believes would not add to the understanding of the issue by the Board.

Where Mr. Hughes is paid Directors' fees by an affiliated corporation for his service as a director, Mr. Hughes' time spent in Directors' meetings for that company is not charged as an Inter-corporate charge.
