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- Q. Has the Company conducted a cost analysis to determine the advantage/ disadvantage, as the case may be, when considering stand-by and call-in and overtime for outages which occur when there is no regular shift on duty. Please provide particulars.
- 5 6 A. Newfoundland Power's regional management conduct periodic informal reviews of the 7 advantages and disadvantages of responding to trouble calls with line personnel on stand-8 by versus an evening and weekend shift arrangement. Based on the current volume of 9 trouble calls, the only area where an evening and weekend line crew shift operation is 10 justified is St. John's. All other areas rely on an employee on-call system to respond to trouble calls outside of regular shifts.
