1	Q.	In reference to the evidence of Barry Perry, please advise if Mr. Perry is an expert
2		on depreciation and if it is the intention of the Company that he testify as an expert
3		on depreciation.
4		
5	A.	Mr. Perry is Newfoundland Power's Vice President of Finance and Chief Financial
6		Officer and in that capacity is responsible for financial accounting and reporting and the
7		Company's financial results, including the appropriate recording and reporting of
8		depreciation.
9		
10		Depreciation can have a major effect on the financial accounting and reporting and
11		financial results of the Company. Mr. Perry's testimony in this area is necessary in
12		providing an adequate understanding of the impact on Newfoundland Power of decisions
13		regarding the Company's recording and reporting of depreciation.
14		
15		Newfoundland Power's 2003 General Rate Application filed on October 11, 2002
16		contains a depreciation study completed by Gannett Fleming, Inc, who are experts in this
