Q.	Is there any evidence that Newfoundland Power's monopoly position in the provision of electricity will be challenged by competition in the next 5 years?
A.	Newfoundland Power does not presently possess any specific evidence that its role in the provision of electricity will be challenged by competition in the next five years.
