- A. The amount of the charges associated with intercompany transactions is not calculated based on one specific formula. The calculation of the charges varies according to the nature of the transactions. For example, direct expenses from third parties such as travel and contractor costs are passed on at cost. Staff charges are calculated at individual salary rates plus a loading factor to recover related overheads (in 2002 the loading factor was 28%). Certain engineers and technicians are charged at market rates.
- We have not conducted an analysis of the change, if any, in the formula used by theCompany to calculate intercompany transactions.
