7 **excess of \$50,000, including the total cost of the project and the reason (ie. storm**
8 **damage, deterioration detected during normal inspection or in the undertaking of**
9 **other work, or other) for the replacement.**

11 A. Reconstruction jobs involve repairs or replacement of deteriorated or storm damaged
12 distribution structures and/or electrical equipment and is generally comprised of smaller
13 jobs that are identified during the year as a result of line inspections, or recognized
14 following operational problems.

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16 Each operating area of the Company maintains a single Reconstruction account and the
17 cost of each individual reconstruction job is charged to that account. However, the
18 Company's accounting system does not maintain the information on the cost and the
19 reason for the reconstruction on a job-by-job basis.

21 The value of individual reconstruction jobs can vary considerably. However, the
22 Company would not expect there to be any individual Reconstruction jobs that exceed
23 \$50,000.
