14		following operational problems.

16		Each operating area of the Company maintains a single Reconstruction account and the
17		cost of each individual reconstruction job is charged to that account. However, the
18		Company's accounting system does not maintain the information on the cost and the
19		reason for the reconstruction on a job-by-job basis.
20		
21		The value of individual reconstruction jobs can vary considerably. However, the
22		Company would not expect there to be any individual Reconstruction jobs that exceed
23		\$50,000.
