A detailed review of our reconstruction activity year-to-date indicates that there have been a total of approximately 160 reconstruction jobs completed between January and June of 2004. The Company would expect a similar number for the reminder of the year for a projection of 320 reconstruction jobs for 2004. Historical information on the number of reconstruction jobs per year is not readily available.
15 16 17 18 19		As explained in response to Request for Information PUB 15.2 NP, the Company's accounting system does not maintain the information on the cost of each individual reconstruction job. However, based on the \$1,372,000 total expenditures for Reconstruction for the period January and June 2004 and a total job count of 160, the average level of expenditure per job has been approximately \$8,600. The Company would expect that each reconstruction job cost less than \$50,000.
