6		As the completion date for the replacement of NLH's Energy Management System
7		has now been extended to 2006, does there continue to be a reason to include this
8		expenditure (\$177,000) in the 2005 Capital Budget?

10	A.	The estimated capital expenditure for the portion of this project associated with the
11		replacement of Newfoundland & Labrador Hydro's Energy Management System (EMS)
12		is \$111,000.
13		
14		The implementation of the EMS is scheduled for 2006, and Hydro has requested that
15		Newfoundland Power complete the upgrading of its communications protocol in 2005.
16		
17		The transfer of SCADA-related information between Newfoundland Power and Hydro is
18		an integral aspect of the new EMS. In order to conduct the necessary testing of the new
19		EMS in advance of commissioning, Hydro will require that the data transfer functionality
20		between the two utilities be in place. Scheduling the upgrade of Newfoundland Power's
21		communications protocol for 2005 will ensure that the required modifications are
22		designed, tested and placed in service in a timely manner.
