15	("Oliver Wyman"), filed a report of findings (the "Oliver Wyman Report") which identified
16	areas for consideration for the Board; and

18	WHEREAS on March 6, 2017 the Oliver Wyman Report was provided to Facility Association
19	for comments; and

21	WHEREAS on March 13, 2017 Facility Association filed comments in response to the Oliver
22	Wyman Report; and
23	WHEREAC - March 16 2017 Oliver Western and data are to Facility Association?
24	WHEREAS on March 16, 2017 Oliver Wyman provided a response to Facility Association's
25	comments on the Oliver Wyman Report; and
2627	WHEREAS based on the record the Board finds that some proposals used by Facility
28	Association in calculating its rate level indications have not been fully justified; and
29	Association in calculating its rate level indications have not been runy justified, and
30	WHEREAS the Board accepts Facility Association's proposals for its Garage rating program
31	with the exception of the selected loss trend rates; and
32	with the exception of the selected loss tiend fates, and
33	WHEREAS substituting alternative assumptions for the selected loss trend rates will not reduce
34	the rate indications below the proposed rates; and
