19	report ("Oliver Wyman Report") of findings with the Board; and

21	WHEREAS on April 11, 2018 Royal and Sun Alliance Insurance Company of Canada filed
22	comments and an amended rating program in response to the Oliver Wyman Report; and

24	WHEREAS based on the record the Board finds that some proposals used by Royal and Sur
25	Alliance Insurance Company of Canada in calculating its rate level indications have not been fully
26	justified; and
27	
28	WHEREAS substituting alternative assumptions will not reduce the rate indications below the
29	proposed rates; and
30	TENTENDEN ACIDE TO THE COMPANY OF TH
31	WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are not too high in the circumstances.

33	IT IS THENERODE ORDEDED THAT.
34	IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The revised rating program received April 11, 2018 from Royal and Sun Alliance Insurance

Company of Canada is approved to be effective no sooner than June 1, 2018 for new business
