14	WHEREAS on July 20, 2020 Traders General Insurance Company applied to the Board for
15	approval to extend the range of deductibles for its Private Passenger Automobiles category of
16	automobile insurance; and

18	WHEREAS Traders proposed to increase its range of deductibles from a current maximum of
19	\$2,500 to a new maximum of \$10,000 for Collision, Comprehensive and Specified Perils
20	coverages; and

22	WHEREAS Traders provided rationale for its proposed deductible differentials; and

24	WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the
25	circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the
26	financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the Automobile Insurance Act or the
27	Insurance Companies Act or the respective regulations thereunder.
