1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Automobile*  
2 *Insurance Act*, RSNL 1990, c. A-22,  
3 as amended, and regulations  
4 thereunder; and

6 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application  
7 by The Dominion of Canada General  
8 Insurance Company for approval  
9 to implement a revised rating program  
10 for its Public Vehicles category of  
11 automobile insurance.

14 **WHEREAS** on October 27, 2020 The Dominion of Canada General Insurance Company  
15 (“Dominion”) applied to the Board for approval of a revised rating program under the Mandatory  
16 Simplified filing option for its Publics Vehicles category of automobile insurance; and  
17

18 **WHEREAS** the proposal includes the following types of Public Vehicles: (i) Buses and (ii)  
19 Funeral Vehicles; and  
20

21 **WHEREAS** Dominion does not have sufficient volume to perform any actuarial analysis for  
22 Public Vehicles; and  
23

24 **WHEREAS** Dominion proposed no rating program changes; and  
25

26 **WHEREAS** the Board finds that the proposal is made in accordance with the Board’s Mandatory  
27 Simplified Filing Guidelines; and  
28

29 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the  
30 circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the  
31 financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the *Automobile Insurance Act* or the  
32 *Insurance Companies Act* or the respective regulations thereunder.


