1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Automobile*  
2 *Insurance Act*, RSNL 1990, c. A-22,  
3 as amended, and regulations  
4 thereunder; and  
5

6 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application  
7 by Co-operators General Insurance  
8 Company for approval to implement a  
9 revised rating program for its Antique  
10 Vehicles class of automobile insurance.

13 **WHEREAS** on July 3, 2020 Co-operators General Insurance Company (“Co-operators”) applied  
14 to the Board for approval of a revised rating program under the Mandatory Simplified filing option  
15 for its Antique Vehicles class of automobile insurance, effective November 18, 2020 for new  
16 business and January 2, 2021 for renewals; and  
17

18 **WHEREAS** Co-operators filed an overall rate level indication of 0.6% and proposed an overall  
19 rate level change of 0.4%; and  
20

21 **WHEREAS** Co-operators noted that it only proposed half of its calculated rate level indication,  
22 subject to rounding, due to the small book of business for Antique Vehicles, the low credibility of  
23 the company’s own experience and the heavy influence that industry data had on the indication;  
24 and

26 **WHEREAS** the Board finds that the proposal is made in accordance with the Board’s Mandatory  
27 Simplified Filing Guidelines and is supported; and

29 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the  
30 circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the  
31 financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the *Automobile Insurance Act* or the  
32 *Insurance Companies Act* or the respective regulations thereunder.

35 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**


- 37 1. The proposal received July 3, 2020 from Co-operators General Insurance Company for its  
38 Antique Vehicles class of automobile insurance is approved to be effective no sooner than  
39 November 18, 2020 for new business and January 2, 2021 for renewals.
