AN ORDER OF THE BOARD

1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Automobile*
2 *Insurance Act*, RSNL 1990, c. A-22,
3 as amended, and regulations
4 thereunder; and
5

6 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application
7 by Traders General Insurance Company
8 for approval to implement a revised
9 rating program for its Motorcycles
10 class of automobile insurance.

13 **WHEREAS** on September 30, 2020 Traders General Insurance Company (“Traders”) applied to
14 the Board for approval of a revised rating program under the Mandatory Simplified filing option
15 for its Motorcycles class of automobile insurance, effective April 1, 2021 for new business and
16 renewals; and

18 **WHEREAS** Traders does not have sufficient volume to perform an actuarial analysis for
19 Motorcycles; and
20

21 **WHEREAS** Traders compared its average written premium against the industry average written
22 premium and determined that a rate change was not warranted; and
23

24 **WHEREAS** Traders proposed various rating program changes which results in an overall rate
25 level impact of 0.02%; and
26

27 **WHEREAS** the Board finds that the proposal is made in accordance with the Board’s Mandatory
28 Simplified Filing Guidelines and is supported; and
29

30 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the
31 circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the
32 financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the *Automobile Insurance Act* or the
33 *Insurance Companies Act* or the respective regulations thereunder.


1 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

- 3 1. The revised rating program received September 30, 2020 from Traders General Insurance
4 Company for its Motorcycles class of automobile insurance is approved to be effective no
5 sooner than April 1, 2021 for new business and renewals.
