- WHEREAS the IAO filing option may be used by insurers to adopt the most recent IAO rating
 program accepted for use by the Board; and
- WHEREAS the IAO filing option may also be used to introduce deviations to the IAO rating
 program by insurers that are proposing to adopt or are currently using IAO rates; and

- WHEREAS FICC proposed to adopt and introduce the IAO rating program for Private Passenger
 Automobiles accepted for use by the Board in Information Bulletin A.I. 2020-08 issued on
 September 14, 2020; and

- 30 **WHEREAS** FICC proposed to align with its partner company, Northbridge General Insurance 31 Company ("NGIC"), by adopting the same deviations to the IAO rating program, underwriting 32 rules, endorsements and rating rules approved for NGIC in Order No. A.I. 27(2021); and

- 34 WHEREAS FICC proposed to adopt 2021 CLEAR; and

WHEREAS the proposed rating program is filed in accordance with the IAO Filing Guidelines
 and is supported; and

4 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the 5 circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the 6 financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the *Automobile Insurance Act* or the 7 *Insurance Companies Act* or the respective regulations thereunder.
