18	WHEREAS Verassure proposed to align with its partner company, Northbridge General
19	Insurance Company ("NGIC"), by adopting the same rating program, underwriting rule changes,
20	endorsement changes and rating rule changes approved for NGIC in Order No. A.I. 32(2021); and

22	WHEREAS Verassure noted that it has zero exposures and thus does not have sufficient volume
23 24	to justify a rating program based on company specific data; and
