13	WHEREAS on November 10, 2021 Traders General Insurance Company ("Traders") applied to
14	the Board for approval of rating program changes under the Supplemental filing option for its
15	Miscellaneous Vehicles category of automobile insurance; and
16	
17	WHEREAS on November 5, 2021 Steers Insurance started transferring a portfolio of
18	Miscellaneous Vehicles over to Traders; and
19	
20	WHEREAS Traders proposes to introduce a +15% upper bound cap to manage the dislocation of
21	the customers in this portfolio transfer; and
22	
23	WHEREAS the capping provision is proposed to remain effective for two renewals until
24	November 4, 2023, at which time the risks in the portfolio transfer will assume the upper bound
25	cap in effect for Traders Miscellaneous Vehicles at the time; and
26	
27	WHEREAS the proposal is filed in accordance with the Supplemental Filing Guidelines and is
28	supported; and
29	
30	WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed changes are just and reasonable in the
31	circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the
32 33	financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the <i>Automobile Insurance Act</i> or the <i>Insurance Companies Act</i> or the respective regulations thereunder.
