 volume to justify a rating program based on company specific data; and

- WHEREAS the revised rating program is filed in accordance with the IAO Filing Guidelines andis supported; and

- WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the *Automobile Insurance Act* or the
- 32 *Insurance Companies Act* or the respective regulations thereunder.

The revised rating program received November 19, 2021 from Hartford Fire Insurance
 Company for its Commercial Vehicles category of automobile insurance is approved to be
 effective no sooner than March 1, 2022 for new business.
