1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Automobile*
2 *Insurance Act*, RSNL 1990, c. A-22,
3 as amended, and regulations
4 thereunder; and

6 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application
7 by Aviva Insurance Company of Canada
8 for approval to implement rating program
9 changes for its Commercial and
10 Interurban Vehicles category of
11 automobile insurance.

14 **WHEREAS** on February 4, 2022 Aviva Insurance Company of Canada (“Aviva”) applied to the
15 Board for approval of rating program changes under the Supplemental filing option for its
16 Commercial and Interurban Vehicles category of automobile insurance; and

18 **WHEREAS** Aviva proposed to update the vehicle rate group tables for its Commercial and
19 Interurban Vehicles to the 2022 MSRP and Listed Price New tables; and
20

21 **WHEREAS** the overall rate level impact of the proposed changes is -0.21% and -0.93% for
22 Commercial Vehicles and Interurban Vehicles respectively; and


24 **WHEREAS** the proposal is filed in accordance with the Supplemental Filing Guidelines and is
25 supported; and

27 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed changes are just and reasonable in the
28 circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the
29 financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the *Automobile Insurance Act* or the
30 *Insurance Companies Act* or the respective regulations thereunder.


33 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**
