20	WHEREAS Sompo Japan stated it relied on the 2022 IAO Actuarial Consulting Services Inc. Auto
21	Manual to set premiums for the proposed endorsements; and

23	WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposal is just and reasonable in the circumstances
24	does not impair the solvency of the insurer, is not excessive in relation to the financia
25	circumstances of the insurer, and does not violate the Automobile Insurance Act or the
26	Insurance Companies Act or the respective regulations thereunder.
