14	WHEREAS on July 14, 2023 XL Specialty Insurance Company ("XL") applied to the Board for
15	approval of a revised rating program under the IAO filing option for its Miscellaneous Vehicles
16	category of automobile insurance; and

18	WHEREAS the IAO filing option may be used by insurers to adopt IAO advisory rates accepted for
19	use by the Board; and
20	
21	WHEREAS XL proposed to adopt the most recent IAO advisory rates for Miscellaneous Vehicles
22	accepted for use by the Board; and
23	
24	WHEREAS XL has no Miscellaneous Vehicles exposures and thus does not have sufficient volume
25	to justify a rating program based on company specific data; and
26	
27	WHEREAS the revised rating program is filed in accordance with the IAO Filing Guidelines; and

29	WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the
30	circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the
31	financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the Automobile Insurance Act or the
32	Insurance Companies Act or the respective regulations thereunder.
