17	Private Buses, School Buses, and Taxis, Limousines & Funeral Vehicles; and

19	WHERAS NGIC proposed various changes to differentials, endorsements, and underwriting rules;

WHEREAS the proposed changes result in overall rate level changes as follows:

Ambulances	-12.86%
Public Bus	-0.12%
Private Bus	-7.30%
School Bus	-4.16%
Taxis, Limousines & Funeral Vehicles	-7.56%
Overall	-10.3%

WHEREAS NGIC does not have sufficient volume to perform a full actuarial analysis for its Public Vehicles classes; and

WHEREAS the revised rating program is filed in accordance with the Mandatory Simplified Filing
 Guidelines; and

WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the **Automobile Insurance Act** or the **Insurance Companies Act** or the respective regulations thereunder.
