17	WHEREAS Intact filed an overall rate level indication of +4.5% and proposed an overall rate level
18	change of +4.5% based on revisions directed by the Board for the inflation adjustment and
19	contingent commissions provision; and
20 21	WHEREAS on November 7, 2022 the Board's actuarial consultants. Oliver Wyman Limited
22	WHEREAS on November 7, 2023 the Board's actuarial consultants, Oliver Wyman Limited, reported that the revised assumptions and resulting rate level indications were consistent with
23	the parameters specified by the Board in Order No. A.I. 41(2023); and
24	the parameters specified by the board in Order No. A.I. 41(2025), and
25	WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the
26	circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the
27	financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the Automobile Insurance Act or the
28	Insurance Companies Act or the respective regulations thereunder.
