17	WHEREAS Aviva proposes an average overall rate level change of 0%; and

19	WHEREAS the filing proposes the introduction of DCPD deductibles and no other changes to the
20	rating program; and
21	WHITEREAS Avive did not perform an actuarial analysis in support of its proposal due to its limited
