 Miscellaneous Vehicles category of automobile insurance, including ATVs, Motorcycles,
 Motorhomes, Motorized Snow Vehicles, and Trailers and Camper Units; and

- WHEREAS S&Y proposed no change to its rates or rating elements, resulting in a 0% overall rate
 level change; and

- WHEREAS S&Y did not perform an actuarial analysis in support of its proposal due to its limited
 exposure count and lack of credible data; and

- WHEREAS S&Y compared its average written premium against that of industry and deemed its
 rates to be reasonable on this basis; and

- WHEREAS the revised rating program is filed in accordance with the Mandatory Simplified FilingGuidelines; and

- 30 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the 31 circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the 32 financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the **Automobile Insurance Act** or the
- 33 **Insurance Companies Act** or the respective regulations thereunder.

- The revised rating program received November 1, 2023 from S&Y Insurance Company for its
 Miscellaneous Vehicles category of automobile insurance, including ATVs, Motorcycles,

- 6 effective no sooner than March 1, 2024 for new business and renewals.
