A-22, 3 as amended and regulations 4 thereunder; and 5 6 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application by 7 Traders General Insurance Company for 8 approval to implement rating program 9 changes for its Private Passenger 10 Automobiles category of automobile 11 insurance. 12 13 14 WHEREAS on May 6, 2025 Traders General Insurance Company ("Traders") applied to the Board 15 under the Supplemental filing option for approval of rating program changes applicable to its 16 Private Passenger Automobiles category of automobile insurance; and 17 18 WHEREAS Traders proposed surcharge and endorsement changes; and 19 20 WHEREAS the overall rate level impact associated with this filing is +0.0%; and 21 22 **WHEREAS** the proposal is filed in accordance with the Supplemental Filing Guidelines; and 23 24 WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the 25 circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the 26 financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the Automobile Insurance Act or the 27 Insurance Companies Act or the respective regulations thereunder. 28 29 30 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT: 31 32 1. The proposal received May 6, 2025 from Traders General Insurance Company for its Private 33 Passenger Automobiles category of automobile insurance is approved to be effective no
- 34 sooner than February 1, 2026 for new business and renewals.
