IN THE MATTER OF the Petroleum Products Act, SNL 2001, Chapter P-10.1 and regulations thereunder; and **IN THE MATTER OF** the suspension of maximum price adjustments for gasoline and diesel motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11b, 12 and 14. WHEREAS in Order No. P.P. 73(2023) the Board approved the lifting of the suspension of maximum price adjustments, effective November 30, 2023, for gasoline and diesel motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11b, 12 and 14; and WHEREAS delivery information provided by suppliers to the region confirms that the winter resupply of gasoline and diesel motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel to Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11b, 12 and 14 has been completed and, as a result, the Board is satisfied that it is appropriate at this time to address the suspension of maximum price adjustments in these zones for the upcoming winter; and WHEREAS based on the information provided the Board is satisfied that the seasonal suspension of maximum price adjustments for gasoline and diesel motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11b, 12 and 14 should be implemented until resupply of product in the spring. **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**
