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30	WHEREAS the Applicant is a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the
31	Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a public utility within the meaning of the Act, and is
32	also subject to the provisions of the Electrical Power Control Act, 1994; and
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34	WHEREAS on May 4, 2004, following Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro's ("Hydro") 2003
35	General Rate Application, the Board issued Order No. P.U. 14 (2004), which among other things,
36	ordered Hydro to file, on or before July 31, 2004, an application for a demand and energy wholesale
37	purchased power rate to be implemented for the Applicant on January 1, 2005; and
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WHEREAS to prepare for the implementation of the demand and energy rate as ordered, it was 1 necessary for the Applicant to consult with Hydro and immediately initiate preparations for demand 2 metering in the Applicant's generating plants; and 3 4 WHEREAS in order for the Applicant to meet the requirements of Hydro for information to support 5 billing under the proposed demand and energy rate it is necessary that the Applicant construct 6 certain improvements and additions to its property; and 7 8 WHEREAS a report detailing the required changes to the Applicant's metering arrangements to 9 accommodate the implementation of the demand and energy rate was submitted as Schedule "A" to 10 the Application; and 11 12 WHEREAS in Order No. P.U. 35 (2003) the Board approved the Applicant's 2003 Capital Budget 13 14 for Energy Supply in the amount of \$5,245,000; and 15 WHEREAS the estimated cost of the proposed improvements and additions is \$100,000, and this 16 expenditure will require a corresponding increase to the Energy Supply budget category and will 17 increase the total approved capital budget for 2004 to \$52,309,000; and 18 19 WHEREAS the proposed expenditures are necessary for the Applicant to provide service and 20 facilities which are reasonably safe and adequate and just and reasonable as required pursuant to 21 Section 37 of the Act. 22

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## **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

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3	1. Pursuant to Section 41(3) of the <i>Act</i> , the Board approves:
4	(a) the construction projects and capital purchases totalling \$100,000, as set forth in
5	Schedule "B" to the Application; and
б	(b) the revised 2004 capital budget totalling \$52,309,000 as set forth in Schedule "C" to
7	the Application.
