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25	WHEREAS the Customer is developing nine (9) residential building lots located in the Town of
26	Reidville; and
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28	WHEREAS the Customer has requested that NP provide a single-phase electrical distribution
29	line for the future connection of electrical services for the building lots under development
30	which, in order to so provide, requires the construction of a single-phase extension of 871 metres
31	(the "Extension"); and

1 WHEREAS the Extension will be jointly used by NP and Aliant Telecom Inc.; and 2 3 WHEREAS the building lot development meets the definition of a Subdivision as set out in 4 Clause 4(a)(ii) of the CIAC Policy: Distribution Line Extensions To Residential and Seasonal 5 Residential Customers approved by Order No. P.U. 7 (1997-98) dated September 30, 1997 (the 6 "Policy"); and 7 8 WHEREAS a CIAC of the Extension has been calculated in accordance with Clause 4(b) of the 9 Policy and the CIAC thus calculated is Eight thousand six hundred twenty-six dollars and fifteen 10 cents (\$8,626.15), including HST; and 11 12 WHEREAS the estimated construction cost of the Extension is \$25,809 and Clause 12(a) of the 13 Policy states that all Lines Extensions or Upgrades involving CIACs where the construction 14 costs are estimated to be greater than \$25,000 must be submitted to the Board for approval; and 15 16 WHEREAS the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that NP's investment in the Extension is 17 compensatory over the useful life of the Extension and will not be to the detriment of NP's other 18 customers.

## **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

2	Pursuant to Section 41(5) of the Act, the Board approves the contribution in aid of
3	construction in the amount of Eight thousand six hundred twenty-six dollars and fifteen cents
4	(\$8,626.15), including HST, as calculated under the Policy to provide single-phase electric
5	service to a subdivision consisting of nine residential building lots located in the Town of
6	Reidville.
