U. 53 (2004) the Board approved Hydro's 2005 capital expenditure 1 2 program with a total budgeted cost of \$42,431,000; and 3 WHEREAS on January 14, 2005 Hydro filed an application with the Board, pursuant to Section 4 5 41(3) of the Act, seeking approval of additional 2005 capital expenditures totaling \$120,000 for the 6 preliminary engineering and related work to be carried out in January and February of 2005 associated with a 55 km transmission interconnection to the Duck Pond Mine site owned by Aur 7 8 Resources Inc., an intended industrial customer of Hydro; and 9 10 WHEREAS Hydro has entered into an agreement with Aur Resources Inc. which provides that this intended industrial customer will pay to Hydro the full cost of this preliminary engineering and 11 12 related works; and 13 14 WHEREAS Hydro anticipates that, in due course, it will make further application to the Board for 15 approval of the construction of the transmission interconnection on the basis that those capital costs 16 will be fully contributed by the intended customer; and 17 18 WHEREAS the Board has considered the application and is satisfied that the proposed expenditure is prudent and necessary in order to preserve a timely commencement of the transmission 19 20 interconnection project. 21
