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17	WHEREAS Newfoundland Power is a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the
18	Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a public utility within the meaning of the Act, and is
19	also subject to the provisions of the <i>EPCA</i> ; and

21	WHEREAS by Order No. P. U. 1(1974) the Board ordered Newfoundland Power to provide a
22	reserve out of its revenue to normalize for the average degree days (the Degree Day Normalization
23	Reserve) and to combine the balance in this reserve with the balance in the Hydro Production
2425	Equalization Reserve established pursuant to Order No. P. U. 32(1968) to create a combined reserve referred to as the Weather Normalization Reserve; and
25 26	referred to as the weather Normanzation Reserve, and
27	WHEREAS by Order No. P. U. 32(2007) the Board ordered Newfoundland Power to amortize the
28	recovery of \$6,800,000 of the balance in the Degree Day Normalization Reserve over a five-year
29	period beginning in 2008; and
30	period beginning in 2000, and
31	WHEREAS by Order No. P. U. 7(2008) the Board approved Newfoundland Power's Weather
32	Normalization Reserve as of December 31, 2007, at which time there was a negative balance in the
33	reserve of \$10,516,682; and
34	
35	WHEREAS Newfoundland Power has reported to the Board that its Weather Normalization
36	Reserve as of December 31, 2008 is a negative balance of \$5,910,271; and

WHEREAS the Board is satisfied from the Application and Affidavit that the reserve at December 31, 2008, properly reflects the effect that degree days and hydro equalization have had on the operation of Newfoundland Power from January 1, 2008 to December 31, 2008, and the Board's approval of the amortization of the recovery of \$6,800,000 of the balance in the Degree Day Normalization Reserve over five years beginning in 2008.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The Board approves Newfoundland Power's Weather Normalization Reserve of a negative balance of \$5,910,271 as of December 31, 2008, pursuant to subsections 69(3) and 78 of the *Act*.

2. Newfoundland Power shall pay all costs and expenses of the Board in connection with this Application.
