U. 12 (2001-1002), dated July 26, 2001, the Board approved capital projects to improve service reliability for customers in the towns from Point May to Lawn and surrounding areas (the "Area") including the construction of a new substation near the community of Lawn and rebuilding portions of the distribution feeder serving the Area (Laurentian-02); and WHEREAS the rebuilt portion of Laurentian-02 has replaced a twelve-kilometre section of the Laurentian-02 feeder running between St. Lawrence and Lawn (the "Line"); and WHEREAS with the completion of this work, Newfoundland Power has de-energized the Line and has now applied to decommission it as it is no longer useful; and WHEREAS Newfoundland Power states that removal of the Line from service will not adversely 	1	IN THE MATTER OF the Electrical Power
