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15	WHEREAS Hydro is a corporation continued and existing under the <i>Hydro Corporation Act</i> , is

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18	WHEREAS on June 4, 2009 Hydro applied to the Board requesting approval of the capital		
19	expenditure of \$2,804,700 for the rehabilitation of the Nain Diesel Generating Plant; and

- (ii) Order No. P.U. 8(2009) in the amount of \$1,092,900 for the replacement of programmable logic controllers at the Holyrood Thermal Generating Station's Gas Turbine Plant;
 - (iii) Order No. P. U. 10(2009) in the amount of \$703,700 for the upgrade of the continuous emission monitoring system at the Holyrood Thermal Generating Station;
 - (iv) Order No. P. U. 16(2009) in the amount of \$93,000 for the extension of the parking lot at Hydro Place;
 - (v) Order No. P. U. 19 (2009) in the amount of \$191,600 to install cold reheat condensate drains and high-pressure heater trip on Unit 2 at the Holyrood Thermal Generating Station in place of the same project for Unit 1;
 - (vi) Order No. P. U. 23(2009) in the amount of \$160,000 for the development of an on-line WPC training software program; and
 - (vii) Order No. P.U. 28(2009) in the amount of \$1,895,000 for a Condition Assessment and Life Extension Study for the Holyrood Thermal Generating Station; and

WHEREAS Hydro owns, operates and maintains a Diesel Generating Plant in the northern Labrador community of Nain, which contains three 865 kW diesel generating units, Units 574, 575 and 576; and

WHEREAS on September 7, 2008 a fire destroyed generating Unit 575 and severely damaged the engine hall at the Nain Diesel Generating Plant, causing an outage for customers, which the Board was notified of in an Outage Advisory (2008-H-19-A); and

WHEREAS in P.U. Order No. 2 (2009) the Board approved Hydro's application to relocate two portable generators to the Nain Diesel Generating Plant while it is being repaired following the September 7, 2008 fire; and

WHEREAS Hydro has completed the damage assessment and investigation of alternatives to restore the plant; and

WHEREAS the Application seeks approval to replace the 865 kW generating unit destroyed by fire in 2008 with a 1,275 kW generating unit, install a hydronic heating system, and install a new sewer system; and

WHEREAS the Board has reviewed the supporting documentation filed with the Application in the context of the *Act* and the Capital Budget Application Guidelines issued by the Board; and

WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that it is reasonable and prudent to approve the expenditure of \$2,804,700 for the rehabilitation of the Nain Diesel Generating Plant.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The proposed capital expenditures of \$2,804,700 for the rehabilitation of the Nain Diesel Generating Plant is approved.

2. Hydro shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
