30	Service Customers were to be equal to the rate change approved for equivalent classes of

34	WHEREAS Order No. P. U. 1(2009) approved the rates in accordance with the Governmen
35	Directive and required Hydro to file no later than September 30, 2009 its application for approva
36	of rates to be effective January 1, 2010 for Non-Government Rural Isolated Domestic and
