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17	WHEREAS Hydro is a corporation continued and existing under the <i>Hydro Corporation Act</i> , is
18	a public utility within the meaning of the Act, and is subject to the provisions of the EPCA; and
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20	WHEREAS on October 9, 2009 Hydro applied to the Board requesting approval of the capital
21	expenditure of \$196,500 for the replacement of microwave radio equipment between the
22	Godaleich Hill Microwave Site and the Upper Salmon Generating Station; and
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24	WHEREAS subsection 41(3) of the Act states that a public utility shall not proceed with the
25	construction, purchase or lease of improvements or additions to its property where:
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27	a) the cost of construction or purchase is in excess of \$50,000; or

33	WHEREAS in Order No. P.U. 36(2008) issued December 23, 2008 the Board approved, <i>interview of the Product of th</i>
34	alia, Hydro's 2009 Capital Budget of \$47,856,000; and

WHEREAS the Board approved supplementary 2009 Capital expenditures in:

(i) Order No. P.U. 4(2009) in the amount of \$351,000 for the replacement of the power transformer at the Wiltondale terminal station due to a failure of the existing transformer;

 (ii) Order No. P.U. 8(2009) in the amount of \$1,092,900 for the replacement of programmable logic controllers at the Holyrood Thermal Generating Station's Gas Turbine Plant;

(iii) Order No. P. U. 10(2009) in the amount of \$703,700 for the upgrade of the continuous emission monitoring system at the Holyrood Thermal Generating Station;

(iv) Order No. P. U. 16(2009) in the amount of \$93,000 for the extension of the parking lot at Hydro Place;

(v) Order No. P. U. 19(2009) in the amount of \$191,600 to install cold reheat condensate drains and high-pressure heater trip on Unit 2 at the Holyrood Thermal Generating Station in place of the same project for Unit 1;

(vi) Order No. P. U. 23(2009) in the amount of \$160,800 for the development of an on-line WPC training software program; and

(vii) Order No. P.U. 28(2009) in the amount of \$1,895,000 for a Condition Assessment and Life Extension Study for the Holyrood Thermal Generating Station; and

 (viii) Order No. P. U. 31(2009) in the amount of \$2,804,700 for the rehabilitation of the Nain Diesel Generating Plant; and
 (ix) Order No. P. U. 33(2009) in the amount of \$2,086,200 for the refurbishment of a

gas turbine generator to be located in the Stephenville Gas Turbine Plant; and (x) Order No. P. U. 34(2009) in the amount of \$1,136,000 for the Hinds Lake powerhouse slope stabilization; and

WHEREAS Hydro owns, operates and maintains the Godaleich Hill Microwave Site which provides communications to the Upper Salmon Generating Station via Alcatel MDR-6000 microwave radio; and

WHEREAS this microwave radio system is the communications link that permits the remote operation of the 84 MW Upper Salmon hydro-electric generating station and the Ebbegunbaeg control structure which controls the release of water between Meelpaeg Lake and Upper Salmon hydro-electric plant; and

WHEREAS this communications link is essential to the safe and reliable operation of the hydroelectric plants on the Bay D'Espoir watershed; and

WHEREAS in August 2009 the microwave radio link between the Godaleich Hill Microwave Site and the Upper Salmon Generating Station experienced a failure in one of its modules which is irreparable; and

	WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that it is reasonable and prudent to approve the expenditure of \$196,500 for the replacement of microwave radio equipment between the Godaleich Hill Microwave Site and the Upper Salmon Generating Station.

	1.	The proposed capital expenditure of \$196,500 for the replacement of microwave radio equipment between the Godaleich Hill Microwave Site and the Upper Salmon Generating Station is approved.
