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WHEREAS Newfoundland Power Inc. ("Newfoundland Power") is a corporation duly
organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a
public utility within the meaning of the *Act*, and is also subject to the provisions of the *EPCA*; and

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WHEREAS on May 1, 2012 Newfoundland Power filed an application for approval of a Contribution in Aid of Construction ("CIAC") for a single-phase line extension of approximately 5,173 metres (the "Extension") to serve Domestic Customers in a cottage area known as Tobacco Road located on the Burin Peninsula; and

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WHEREAS twenty-three of forty-two potential customers have requested that
Newfoundland Power provide electrical service (the "Participating Customers"); and

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WHEREAS the Participating Customers have requested the Non-Refundable CIAC Option
 provided for in Clause 6 of Newfoundland Power's CIAC Policy; and

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WHEREAS the number of Participating Customers meets the minimum participation
 percentage of 50% required to avail of the Non-Refundable CIAC Option; and

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36 **WHEREAS** the Non-Refundable CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 6 of the 37 CIAC Policy, is three thousand seven hundred and five dollars and ninety-four cents 38 (\$3,705.94), excluding HST; and

WHEREAS the sum of the Non-Refundable CIAC calculated pursuant to Clause 6 and the 1 2 Basic Investment calculated pursuant to Clause 3 exceeds \$50,000, and therefore in 3 accordance with Clause 10(i) of the CIAC Policy Board approval is required; and

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5 WHEREAS the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that Newfoundland Power's investment is compensatory over the useful life of the Extension and will not be to the 6 detriment of Newfoundland Power's other customers. 7

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# **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

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- 1. The Non-Refundable Contribution in Aid of Construction of three thousand seven 11 12 hundred and five dollars and ninety-four cents (\$3,705.94), excluding HST, to apply to Domestic Customers located in the cottage area known as Tobacco Road is approved.
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- 15 2. Newfoundland Power shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
