15	WHEREAS Newfoundland Power Inc. ("Newfoundland Power") is a corporation duly
16	organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a public
17	utility within the meaning of the Act, and is also subject to the provisions of the EPCA; and

19	WHEREAS by Order No. P.U. 1(1974) the Board ordered that Newfoundland Power create a
20	Weather Normalization Reserve to normalize purchased power costs for variations in
21	hydroelectric production caused by varying levels of precipitation, as well as any variations in
22	kilowatt hours sold and purchased caused by varying temperatures and wind speed; and

24	WHEREAS by Order No. P.U. 32(2007), the Board ordered Newfoundland Power to amortize
25	the recovery of \$6,800,000 of the balance in the Degree Day Normalization Reserve over a five-
26	year period beginning in 2008 and the amortized amount net of income tax for 2011 is
27	\$1,366,300; and
28	WHERE AC Northwest and Decree to a constant to the Decod that the West on New Many
29	WHEREAS Newfoundland Power has reported to the Board that its Weather Normalization
30	Reserve as of December 31, 2011, including the \$1,366,300 ordered to be amortized in Order
31 32	No. P.U. 32(2007), has a positive balance of \$5,019,776; and
33	WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the Weather Normalization Reserve at December 31,
34	2011 properly reflects the normalization of variations in revenue and expenses caused by
35	meteorological conditions during 2011 and the amortization approved in Order No. P.U.
