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17	WHEREAS Newfoundland Power Inc. ("Newfoundland Power") is a corporation duly
18	organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a
19	public utility within the meaning of the Act, and is also subject to the provisions of the
20	EPCA; and
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22	WHEREAS on November 26, 2012 Newfoundland Power filed an application for approval
23	of a Contribution in Aid of Construction ("CIAC") for a single-phase line extension of
24	approximately 3,152 metres (the Extension") to serve Domestic Customers in a cottage area
25	known as Middle Three Island Pond located near the Town of Torbay; and
26	TENTED TO A CO. 1 C.
27	WHEREAS twelve of twenty-one potential customers have requested that Newfoundland
28	Power provide electrical service (the "Participating Customers"); and
29	WHERE A Called Deutinius time Continue and horse requested the New Defendable CIAC Option
30	WHEREAS the Participating Customers have requested the Non-Refundable CIAC Option
31 32	provided for in Clause 6 of Newfoundland Power's CIAC Policy; and
33	WHEREAS the number of Participating Customers meets the minimum participation
34	percentage of 50% required to avail of the Non-Refundable CIAC Option; and
35	percentage of 50% required to avail of the inon-Kertindaole CFAC Option, and
36	WHEREAS the Non-Refundable CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 6 of the
37	CIAC Policy, is five thousand one hundred fifty dollars and ten cents (\$5,150.10),
38	excluding HST; and

WHEREAS the sum of the Non-Refundable CIAC calculated pursuant to Clause 6 and the Basic Investment calculated pursuant to Clause 3 exceeds \$50,000, and therefore in accordance with Clause 10(i) of the CIAC Policy Board approval is required; and

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WHEREAS the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that Newfoundland Power's investment is compensatory over the useful life of the Extension and will not be to the detriment of Newfoundland Power's other customers.

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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

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1. The Non-Refundable Contribution in Aid of Construction of five thousand one hundred fifty dollars and ten cents (\$5,150.10), excluding HST, to apply to Domestic Customers located in the cottage area known as Middle Three Island Pond is approved.

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2. Newfoundland Power shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
