15	WHEREAS Newfoundland Power Inc. ("Newfoundland Power") is a corporation duly
l6	organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a public
17	utility within the meaning of the Act, and is also subject to the provisions of the EPCA; and

19	WHEREAS by Order No. P.U. 1(1974) the Board ordered that Newfoundland Power create a
20	Weather Normalization Reserve to normalize purchased power costs for variations in
21	hydroelectric production caused by varying levels of precipitation, as well as any variations in
22	kilowatt hours sold and purchased caused by varying temperatures and wind speed; and
23	WITTEDE AC has Onder No. D.H. 22/2007), the Decad and and Newform flood Devices to empetize
24	WHEREAS by Order No. P.U. 32(2007), the Board ordered Newfoundland Power to amortize the recovery of \$6,800,000 of the balance in the Degree Day Normalization Reserve over a five-
25 26	year period beginning in 2008 and the amortized amount net of income tax for 2012 is
20 27	\$1,364,100; and
28	\$1,50 4 ,100, and
29	WHEREAS Newfoundland Power has reported to the Board that its Weather Normalization
30	Reserve as of December 31, 2012, including the \$1,364,100 ordered to be amortized in Order
31	No. P.U. 32(2007), has a positive balance of \$4,803,404; and
32	140.1.0. 32(2007), has a positive buttilee of \$\psi_1,003,101, and
33	WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the Weather Normalization Reserve at December 31,
34	2012 properly reflects the normalization of variations in revenue and expenses caused by
35	meteorological conditions during 2012 and the amortization approved in Order No. P.U.
36	32(2007).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. Newfoundland Power's Weather Normalization Reserve of a positive balance of \$4,803,404 as of December 31, 2012 is approved.

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Newfoundland Power shall pay all costs and expenses of the Board in connection with this Application.
