**AN ORDER OF THE BOARD**

1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Electrical Power*  
2 *Control Act, 1994*, SNL 1994, Chapter E-5.1  
3 (the “*EPCA*”) and the *Public Utilities Act*, RSNL  
4 1990, Chapter P-47 (the “*Act*”), as amended,  
5 and regulations thereunder; and

7 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application by  
8 Newfoundland Power Inc. for approval of a  
9 contribution in aid of construction for single  
10 phase service for Bell Mobility Inc. pursuant  
11 to Section 41 of the *Act*.

13

14 **WHEREAS** Newfoundland Power Inc. (“Newfoundland Power”) is a corporation duly  
15 organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a public  
16 utility within the meaning of the *Act*, and is also subject to the provisions of the *EPCA*; and  
17

18 **WHEREAS** Bell Mobility Inc. (the “Customer”) has requested that Newfoundland Power  
19 provide electrical service to a cell phone tower located off the Trans-Canada Highway near  
20 Thorburn Lake; and  
21

22 **WHEREAS** on October 8, 2014 Newfoundland Power filed an application for approval of a  
23 Contribution in Aid of Construction (“CIAC”) for a single-phase line extension of approximately  
24 1,883 metres (the “Extension”) to supply service to the cell phone tower owned by the Customer;  
25 and  
26

27 **WHEREAS** the CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 5(a) of the CIAC Policy:  
28 Distribution Line Extensions and Upgrades to General Service Customers approved by Order  
29 No. P.U. 27 (2005), dated November 2, 2005, (the “Policy”), is sixty-seven thousand two  
30 hundred seven dollars (\$67,207.00), excluding HST; and  
31

32 **WHEREAS** the estimated construction cost of the extension exceeds \$50,000 and therefore, in  
33 accordance with Clause 10(i) of the Policy, Board approval is required; and  
34

35 **WHEREAS** the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that Newfoundland Power’s investment  
36 is compensatory over the useful life of the Extension and will not be to the detriment of  
37 Newfoundland Power’s other customers.


1 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

- 3 1. The Contribution in Aid of Construction of sixty-seven thousand two hundred seven  
4 dollars (\$67,207.00), excluding HST, to provide single-phase service to a cell phone  
5 tower for Bell Mobility Inc. is approved.

7 2. Newfoundland Power shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.


