15	WHEREAS Newfoundland Power Inc. ("Newfoundland Power") is a corporation duly
16	organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a public
17	utility within the meaning of the Act, and is also subject to the provisions of the EPCA; and

19	WHEREAS on December 10, 2014 Newfoundland Power filed an application for approval of a
20	Contribution in Aid of Construction ("CIAC") for a single-phase line extension of approximately
21	2,442 metres (the "Extension") to serve Domestic Customers in a cottage area known as Blue Jay
22	Lane, near Brigus Junction; and
23	WITTEREAC Assessed Alama and additional and assessed to the same for t
24	WHEREAS twenty-three potential customers of the area have requested that Newfoundland
25	Power provide electrical service; and
26 27	WHEREAS the CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 5(a) of the CIAC Policy:
28	Distribution Line Extensions to Domestic Customers approved by Order No. P.U. 27 (2005),
29	dated November 2, 2005, (the "Policy"), is two thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven dollars
30	and fifty-two cents (\$2,867.52), excluding HST; and

32	WHEREAS the sum of the CIAC calculated pursuant to Clause 5 and the Basic Investment
33	calculated pursuant to Clause 3 is \$88,903.00 and Clause 10(i) of the Policy states that the
34	Applicant shall apply to the Board for approval of all CIACs where the sum of the CIAC
35	calculated pursuant to Clause 5(a) or Clause 6(a) and the Basic and Additional Investment
36	calculated pursuant to Clauses 3 and 4 is greater than \$50,000; and
