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13	WHEREAS Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") is a corporation continued and
14 15	existing under the Hydro Corporation Act, is a public utility within the meaning of the Act, and
16	is subject to the provisions of the EPCA; and
17	WHEREAS subsection 41(3) of the Act states that a public utility shall not proceed with the
18	construction, purchase or lease of improvements or additions to its property where:
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20	a) the cost of construction or purchase is in excess of \$50,000; or
21	b) the cost of the lease is in excess of \$5,000 in a year of the lease
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23	without prior approval of the Board; and
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25	WHEREAS in Order No. P.U. 50(2014) the Board approved Hydro's 2015 Capital Budget in
26	the amount of \$76,832,900; and
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28	WHEREAS on July 3, 2015 Hydro filed an application with the Board requesting approval of a
29	supplemental 2015 capital expenditure of \$1,536,300 to purchase critical spares for its generation
30	stations (the "Application"); and
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32	WHEREAS as part of its critical spares review, Hydro identified items that are critical to have
33	available to facilitate an expedited return to service in the event of an unexpected failure of an in-
34	service component; and
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36 37	WHEREAS the Application was copied to: Newfoundland Power Inc.; the Consumer Advocate, Mr. Thomas Johnson; Corner Brook Pulp and Paper Limited; NARL Refining Limited

Partnership and Teck Resources Limited; Vale Newfoundland and Labrador Limited and Praxair Canada Inc.; and

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WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the 2015 supplemental capital expenditure to purchase critical spares for Hydro's Generation Stations are necessary to allow Hydro to provide service

WHEREAS the Board did not receive any comments or submissions on the Application; and

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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

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- 1. The capital expenditure in the amount of \$1,536,300 to purchase critical spares for the Hydro's Generating Stations is approved.
