16	WHEREAS Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") is a corporation continued and
17	existing under the Hydro Corporation Act, is a public utility within the meaning of the Act, and
18	is also subject to the provisions of the <i>EPCA</i> ; and

20	WHEREAS section 90 of the Act gives the Board the authority and discretion to award costs in
21	a proceeding before the Board; and

23 24	WHEREAS in Order No P.U. 47(2014) the Board granted leave to the Industrial Customer

28	WHEREAS on December 23, 2014 the Industrial Customer Group filed an application with the
29	Board for approval of costs in the amount of \$9,708.80 (exclusive of HST); and
30	Double for approval of costs in the tunount of ψ5,700.00 (exclusive of 1151), and
31	WHEREAS the Industrial Customer Group submits that their intervention and participation in
32	the utility rate application was reasonably contributory to the application and warrants an award
33	of costs; and
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35	WHEREAS the Board requested comments on the bill of costs from Hydro and on January 29
36	2015 Hydro advised that it did not have any comments; and

WHEREAS the Board finds that the participation of the Industrial Customer Group was helpful to the Board in its consideration of the matter and contributed to the Board's understanding of the issues; and

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WHEREAS the Board has reviewed the bill of costs submitted by the Industrial Customer Group and is satisfied that the Industrial Customer Group's costs should be fixed in the amount of \$9,708.80 (exclusive of HST).

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## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

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1. The costs of the Industrial Customer Group are fixed at \$9,708.80, exclusive of HST.

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2. Hydro shall, within thirty days, pay costs to the Industrial Customer Group in the amount of \$9,708.80.
