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15	WHEREAS Newfoundland Power Inc. ("Newfoundland Power") is a corporation duly
16	organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a public
17	utility within the meaning of the Act, and is also subject to the provisions of the EPCA; and

19	WHEREAS on October 13, 2015 Newfoundland Power filed an application for approval of a
20	Contribution in Aid of Construction ("CIAC") for a single-phase line extension of approximately
21	2,485 metres (the "Extension") to serve Domestic Customers with residences situated in a
22	cottage area known as Butts Pond West located near the Town of Gambo; and
23 24	WITTEDEAS along material of Colonia to the Colonia
2 4 25	WHEREAS eleven potential customers of the area have requested that Newfoundland Power
25 26	provide electrical service; and
	WHEDEAS the CIAC colouleted in accordance with Classes S(A) COLAGE II. Disk is
27 28	WHEREAS the CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 5(a) of CIAC Policy: Distribution
20 29	Line Extensions to Domestic Customers approved by Order No. P.U. 27 (2005), dated November
29 30	2, 2005, (the "Policy"), is seven thousand five hundred fifty four dollars and sixty six cents
31	(\$7,554.66), excluding HST; and
32	WUFDEAS the sum of the CIAC calculated suggested Clause 5 and the David You
33	WHEREAS the sum of the CIAC calculated pursuant to Clause 5 and the Basic Investment
34	calculated pursuant to Clause 3 is \$94,491.25 and Clause 10(i) of the Policy states that the Applicant shall apply to the Board for approval of all CIACs where the sum of the CIAC
35	calculated pursuant to Clause 5(a) or Clause 6(a) and the Basic and Additional Investment
36	calculated pursuant to Clauses 3 and 4 is greater than \$50,000; and
,0	outcommod paradant to Crauses 3 and 4 is greater than \$30,000, and

WHEREAS the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that Newfoundland Power's investment in the Extension is compensatory over the useful life of the Extension and will not be to the detriment of its other customers.

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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

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1. The Refundable Contribution in Aid of Construction of seven thousand five hundred fifty four dollars and sixty six cents (\$7,554.66), excluding HST, to apply to Domestic Customers located in Butts Pond West Cottage Area is approved.

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2. Newfoundland Power shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
