28	WHEREAS in Order No P.U. 36(2015) the Board found that Vale Newfoundland & Labrador
29 30	Limited ("Vale") was entitled to an award of costs; and
31	WHEDEAS on January 12, 2016 Valo filed a cost submission with the Decad for annual of
32	WHEREAS on January 12, 2016 Vale filed a cost submission with the Board for approval of costs in the amount of \$4,167.00 (exclusive of HST); and
33	costs in the amount of \$4,107.00 (exclusive of 1151), and
34	WHEREAS in response to the Board's request for comments on the bill of costs, Hydro advised
35	that it did not have any comments about the particulars of the costs sought; and
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WHEREAS the Board has reviewed the bill of costs submitted by Vale and is satisfied that

Vale's costs should be fixed in the amount of \$4,167.00 (exclusive of HST).

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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The costs of Vale are fixed at \$4,167.00, exclusive of HST.

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2. Hydro shall, within thirty days, pay costs to Vale in the amount of \$4,167.00.
